GENERAL INFORMATION AND SCHOOL REGULATIONS

1. Admission Criteria:

- Children are accepted from **eighteen months to six years** of age.
Preference will be given to siblings.

2. Times:

- The school is open from 07h00 to 13h30. **Children to arrive between 07h00 and 08h00 and be collected between 12h30 and 13h30.**
- **Aftercare** is available at the school from **13h00 until 17h30.**

3. Extra Murals:

13:00 – 13:30	Waiting class. (Aftercare from 13:00 until 17h30).

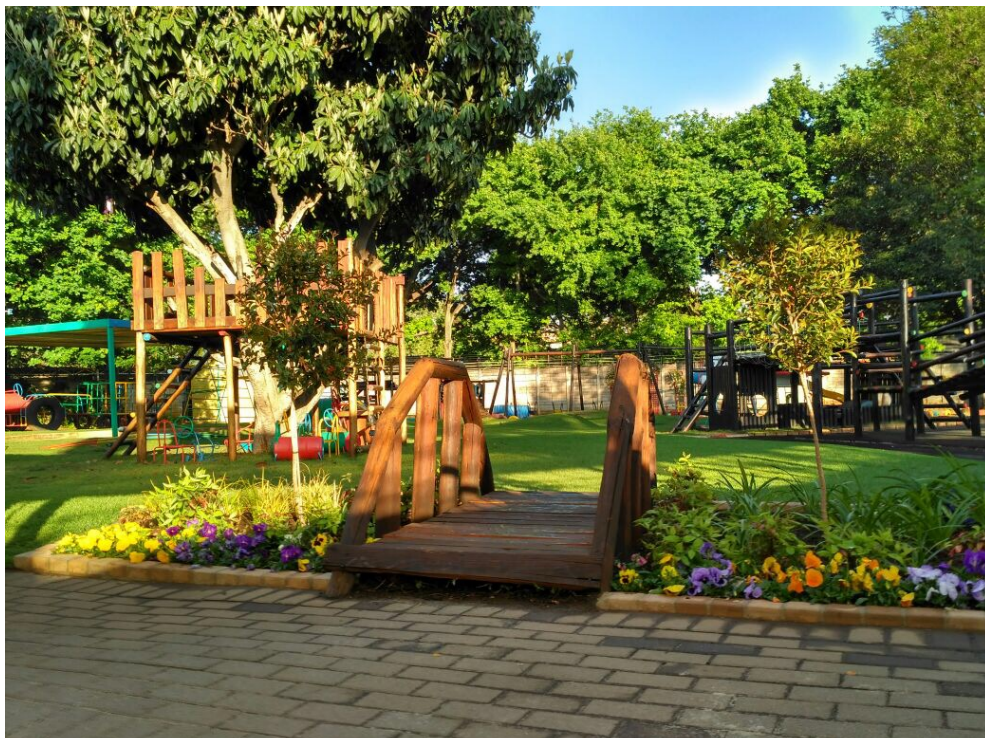
